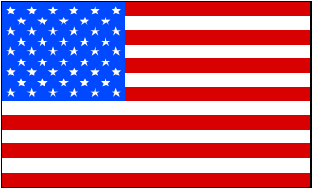

Recycle Your PIKEPASS?

Here's How It Works...

Each PIKEPASS has a battery and must be replaced at some point. We will send you a postcard or email notifying you when its time to recycle. You may either log on to **www.pikepass.com** and recycle by selecting the **"Recycle Your PIKEPASS" link** or call our Customer Service Center to replace your PIKEPASS. We will process your request and mail the replacement PIKEPASS tag(s), with mounting instructions and new Velcro strips, directly to you with instructions on how to return the old PIKEPASS tag(s). That's it - Recycling made easy!

New Audio Tone Feature

Our new style PIKEPASS will begin to use its audio tone (buzzer) feature. By the end of the year, with the completion of upgrades to our lanes, the new style PIKEPASSes will emit a tone identifying to customers that the pass has been "read". This tone will sound anytime you enter, exit, or drive under a PIKEPASS antennae/reader acknowledging the PIKEPASS has been "read".
