PIKEPASS ONLINE Account Management Just Got Easier

For your convenience, you can now manage certain aspects of your PIKEPASS account via the Internet, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. To get started, just visit our website at www.pikepass.com and select the "My Account" option.

Presently you can:

- View Statements
- View Vehicle Information
- Change Billing Information

The first time you visit PIKEPASS Online, you will need to set up your online user account. To do this, select the "set up access" option. Be sure to have the following information handy:

- ✓ PIKEPASS Account Number
- ✓ Primary Account Holder's Drivers License Number
- ✓ Account Access Code (See "What is an Access Code?" article below.)

You will also need to provide a user name, password, email address and a security question and answer. The password will need to be at least 9 characters and must include upper and lowercase and at least one number. If either the driver's license number or the access code are not already on file, you will need to update the information, prior to setting up online access, by calling the Customer Service Center at 1-800-PIKEPASS (1-800-745-3727), M-F, 8:00am-4:30pm CDT, excluding state recognized holidays.



Trial Stroud Midway Full Service Center Convenient for Commuters

Located at the Stroud Midway McDonald's on the Turner Turnpike, the trial Full Service Center (pictured below) is a convenient stop for commuters to make payments, add additional passes and/or take care of other account business. Hours of operation are 7:00am-6:00pm, M-F, excluding state recognized holidays. The trial store will be open through, at least, mid-July.

What is an Access Code?

An Account Access Code is a four digit number used to secure your PIKEPASS account. As of March 1st, when calling the Customer Service Center, **the Account Access Code must be provided before account information can be given or changes made.** The code is also used when setting up online access to your account. (See "PIKEPASS Online" article above.)

If you have not yet established an Access Code, please call 1-800-PIKEPASS (1-800-745-3727), 8:00am-4:30pm CDT, M-F, excluding state recognized holidays, to set one up. Only the account holder (the person who signed the PIKEPASS application) can establish a code on commuter accounts. Only those listed as contacts can establish a code for commercial accounts. Be sure to keep your Access Code secure.

On the Road...

Things to be aware of when traveling Oklahoma Turnpikes.

New Eastbound Exit on Turner

Exit 218A, to W 96th Street/State Highway 66 in Sapulpa, was completed in March and is now open to eastbound travelers on the Turner Turnpike. This project also included widening the turnpike to six lanes near Sapulpa.

Routine Equipment Maintenance

Over the next several months, due to routine maintenance, there will be periodic, partial and complete lane closures at entries and exits system wide. In most cases, traffic will be moved toward the shoulder. Please exercise caution when traveling through these maintenance areas. In the rare instances where a complete ramp closure is required, whenever possible, signs will be posted in advance with dates and times.

Two Turner Turnpike Gas Stations Closing

On April 23, fuel service at two of the Turner Turnpike's service plazas will end. Fuel services westbound, at the Wellston service plaza, and eastbound, at the Bristow service plaza, will cease. McDonald's, the food provider at both of these locations, will not be affected and will remain open, continuing to provide food and facilities to the traveling public.

Fuel service was provided to customers through an automated service at these two locations. Lease agreements at the two sites end in April and the fuel provider has elected not to renew.

At the same time, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority has begun a process to analyze services provided to its customers and determine what's best for those traveling the state's turnpikes. We appreciate our customers and apologize for any inconvenience these closings may cause.
