Dear Oklahoma Turnpike Authority Bondholders:

Oklahoma was hit by a massive ice storm in mid-January. The sleet and freezing rain brought by the storm led to accumulations of ice up to 3 inches thick in some areas. Sub-freezing temperatures accompanying the winter weather prevented the ice from melting off the roadways and made travel hazardous for several days. Numerous business and school closures through the week following the storm also affected traffic patterns. Over 105,000 homes and businesses lost power in the State, prompting Oklahoma Governor Brad Henry to request a federal emergency disaster declaration related to the magnitude of the conditions produced by the winter storm.

As a result of the magnitude of the winter storm, first quarter revenues were negatively impacted, falling to \$45.4 million compared to \$46.3 million for the first quarter of 2006. While January revenues were significantly impacted by the weather, both February and March revenues reported at 1.1% and 2.7%, respectively, greater than the same month's revenues in the prior year. The urban John Kilpatrick and Creek Turnpikes reported overall net toll revenue growth for the first quarter of 2007, in spite of the severe January weather, with a steady increase of 3.8% and 6.1%, respectively, over the prior year. Toll transactions during the first quarter of 2007 surpassed 32.1 million, a slight 1.9% increase over the first quarter of 2006. Transaction growth rates in the first quarter grew 5.4% on the John Kilpatrick Turnpike and 7.5% on the Creek Turnpike over the same period last year.

With revenue fund operating expenses held to 7.9% under the annualized operating budget, controlled spending aided in lessening the storm's impact on total net revenues. As a result, net revenues for the first quarter of 2007 fell just 1.5% short of budget projections. The OTA continues to achieve budgeted senior and total debt service ratios, with total debt service coverage exceeding minimum trust requirements on a rolling twelve-month basis by approximately 17%.

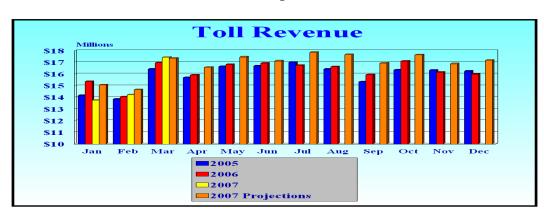


Chart 1: Three-Year Comparison of Toll Revenues

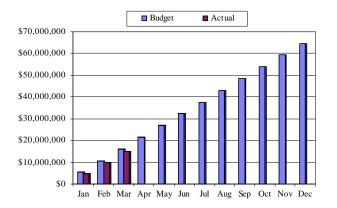
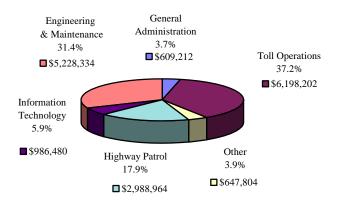


Chart 3: Operating Expenses by Division-All Funds For the Three Months Ended March 31, 2007



First Quarter Highlights:

- The Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA) awarded a Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting to the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority (OTA) for its comprehensive annual financial report (CAFR) for the fiscal year ended December 31, 2005. The Certificate of Achievement is a prestigious national award, recognizing conformance with the highest standards for preparation of state and local government financial reports. In order to be awarded a Certificate of Achievement, a governmental unit must publish an easily readable and efficiently organized CAFR, with contents conforming to program standards. The CAFR must satisfy both accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America and applicable legal requirements. A Certificate of Achievement is valid for a period of one year only. The OTA has received a Certificate of Achievement for sixteen consecutive years. The Controller Division believes the 2006 CAFR will continue to meet the Certificate of Achievement program requirements and plans to submit it to the GFOA to determine its eligibility for another certificate following its release on April 30, 2007.
- The Controller Division worked closely with the OTA's external auditors, Grant Thornton LLP, to provide complete and accurate financial statements, audit schedules and accounting records. This allowed Grant Thornton staff to complete their audit of the annual financial statements within the deadlines required by the Trust Agreement. The audited December 31, 2006 financial statements and a detailed summary of legal and engineering service costs incurred by the OTA were provided to the Governor in compliance with State Statute required deadlines.
- During the first quarter, the Engineering Division was the recipient of several awards. The International Grooving and Grinding Association awarded Tammy Robinson, OTA Professional Engineer, with its Government Official of the Year Award for her contributions in Concrete Pavement Restoration. Additionally, the Oklahoma/Arkansas Chapter of the American Concrete Pavement Association recognized the OTA as the winner in two separate categories of its Award Program. The concrete pavement constructed on the John Kilpatrick Turnpike received an award in the Concrete Pavement Restoration Category. A pavement reconstruction project on the Muskogee Turnpike received an award in the Concrete Overlay Category. The Associated General Contractors also awarded the OTA as the winner in the 2006 Build Oklahoma Award for the Vinita Toll Plaza on the Will Rogers Turnpike.
- Achieving system maintenance, rehabilitation and improvements identified in the 2007 portion of the 5-year Capital Improvement Program remains a priority for the OTA. Various construction projects continued throughout the first quarter. Pavement rehabilitation on the Cimarron Turnpike was completed, as well as pavement rehabilitation on the Cherokee Turnpike, which involved dowel-bar retrofit and diamond grinding. Projects to reconstruct two bridges on the H. E. Bailey Turnpike were awarded, as well as the award of

pavement rehabilitation on the Will Rogers Turnpike. A sign rehabilitation project on the Muskogee Turnpike began in the first quarter.

- During the first quarter of 2007, the Training Branch staff of the Toll Operations Division conducted "Toll Operations Managers' University" which is a customized training seminar. This seminar addresses time management, technical skills, communication skills, report systems, as well as other relevant topics.
- The hazardous winter weather of the first quarter resulted in the plowing and sanding of approximately 90,000 lane miles and the treatment of over 1,200 lane miles with magnesium chloride. The total spent on inclement weather in the first quarter was approximately \$1,931,000. All turnpikes continued joint and crack sealing projects as needed along the System with 244,376 linear feet of joints and cracks sealed during the first quarter of 2007. In addition, the Maintenance Division supervised inmates and utilized contractors in a cost-effective and efficient means of completing various System repairs.
- Staff members of the Information Technology and *PIKEPASS* Customer Service Divisions continued to develop the prototype for the new *PIKEPASS* Customer Service Center software called cEnterprise. Joint development of the new "*PIKEPASS* Online" customer account website continued, with nearly 10,000 customers requesting web access in the first quarter. Continued progress is also being made on the development and implementation of eCommerce account payment, which will provide customers with the ability to make online payments.
- The new *PIKEPASS* customer statement was implemented during January. A redesigned summary section and transaction detail provide additional information and enhanced identification for customer review. Other program and procedural implementations include automated account security enforcement and new account replenishment rules designed to benefit the customer and efficient operations.
- As of March 31, 2007, the total number of active *PIKEPASS* tags increased to 799,928 or 9.2% over the number of first quarter tags in 2006. Total active *PIKEPASS* accounts totaled 432,203, an increase of 7.1% over that of March 31, 2006. *PIKEPASS* patrons continued to take advantage of the *PIKEPASS* volume discount program. Discounts issued to frequent patrons of the System were approximately \$640,000 during the first quarter of 2007, a slight decrease of 1.4% when compared to the first quarter of 2006.
- The Oklahoma Highway Patrol troopers continued their efforts to achieve safe patron travel by maintaining their commitment of System enforcement through several programs including the special enforcement emphasis program, speed enforcement with lasers and radar trailers, aircraft traffic enforcement and the size and weights enforcement program. In the first quarter of 2007, OHP troopers made 24,902 violator contacts.
